DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions for the first night after retinal surgery

During the postoperative period:

- Your eyes may be sensitive to light
- Your eyes may tear and run
- Your nose may run
- You may feel like there's something in your eye
- Your eye may ache
- You may have some nausea and/or vomiting
- You may have a sore throat
- You may see blood on the eye patch
- You may have blood or tears under the patch
- Your face and eyelids may become swollen
- You may have a headache
- Your sleep may be disturbed

Instructions to follow after surgery:

- Position your head as follows _
- Do NOT remove the patch before coming to see the doctor tomorrow
- Keep the patch and shield dry
- Avoid rubbing or bumping your eye
- You may use an ice pack to reduce discomfort and swelling
- You may use ibuprofen and/or tylenol, if needed, to control the pain.
- Avoid heavy lifting and strenuous activities
- Resume your usual outpatient medications
- You should not drive or make important decisions
- You will not use any eye drops in the eye that has had surgery until after your appointment.

If an air or gas bubble was placed in your eye:

- **Do NOT** remove the gas bubble warning bracelet until you are told to so do by the doctor.
- Do NOT fly in an airplane until the bubble is completely gone.
- **Do NOT** dive under water until the bubble is completely gone.
- Do NOT change altitude significantly until the bubble is completely gone.
- **Do NOT** have nitrous oxide (laughing gas) anesthetic until the bubble is gone.
- Do NOT have treatments in a hyperbaric chamber until the bubble is gone.

If you have any of the following please go directly to the Emergency Room or call 911:

- Chest pain
- Severe Sweating
- Loss of consciousness
- Palpitations
- Severe Diarrhea

- Stroke like symptoms
- Shortness of Breath
- Severe Constipation
- Uncontrollable blood sugar (diabetic)
- Severe Nausea
- Severe Weakness
- Severe Vomiting
- Inability to Urinate
- Intractable pain
